

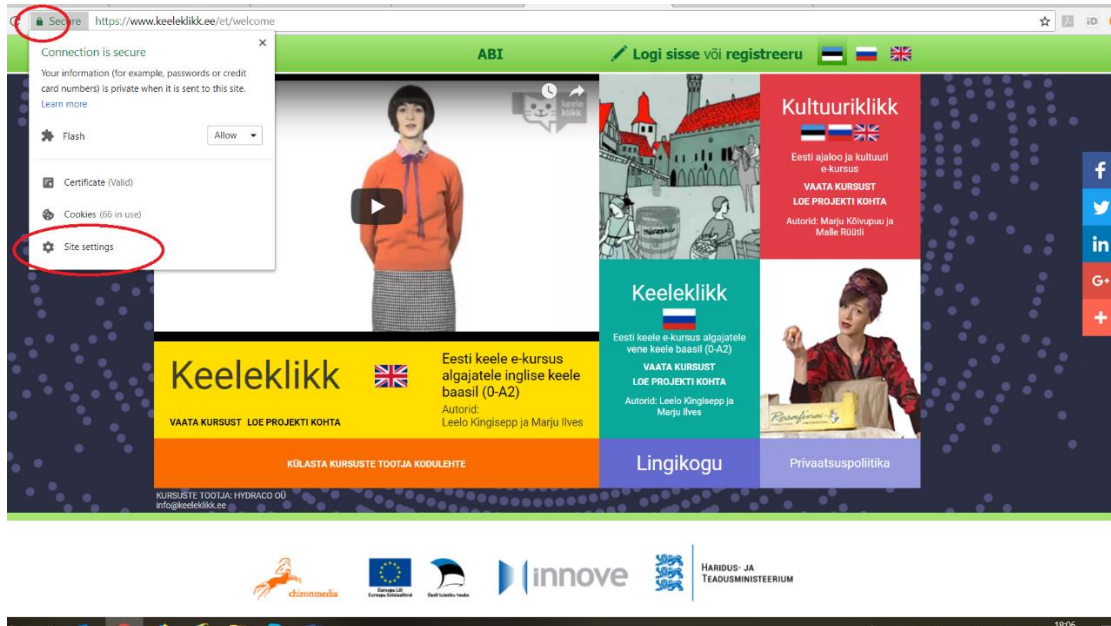


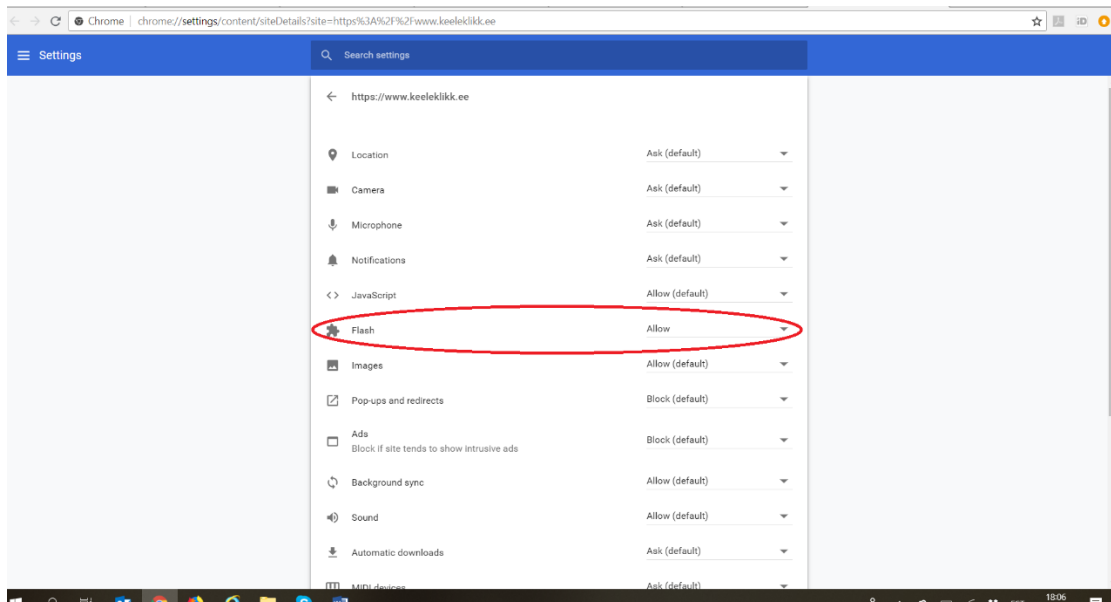
Keeleklikk.ee site needs Flash to work. If the website isn't working, you might need to change your settings to allow Flash.

How to enable Flash on Google Chrome:

1. To the left of the web address, click Lock  or Info .
2. At the bottom, click Site Settings.





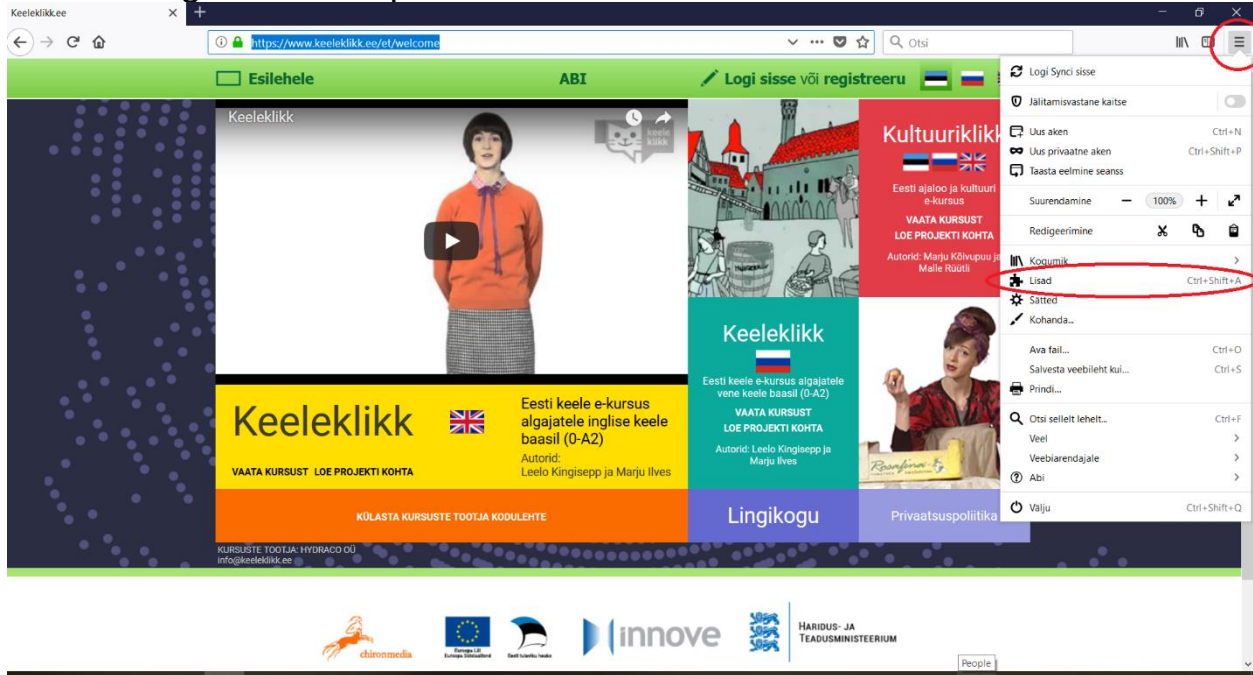
3. In the new tab, to the right of "Flash," click Allow.



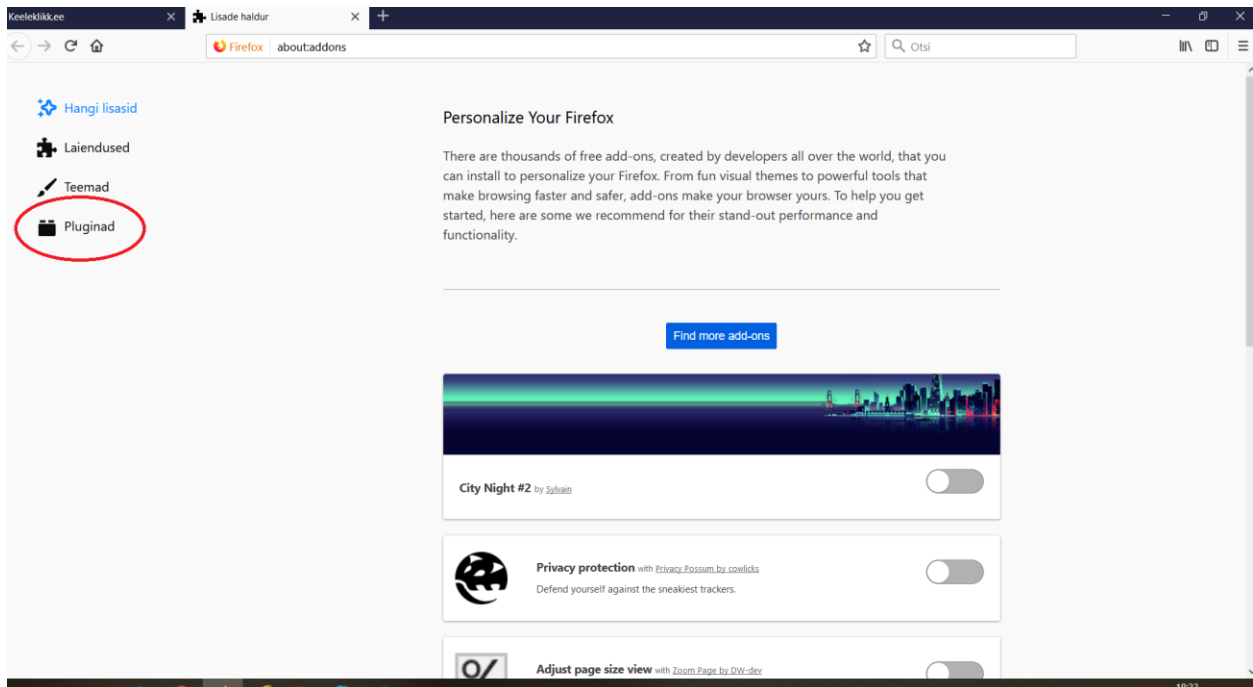
4. Go back to the site and reload the page.

How to enable Flash on Firefox:

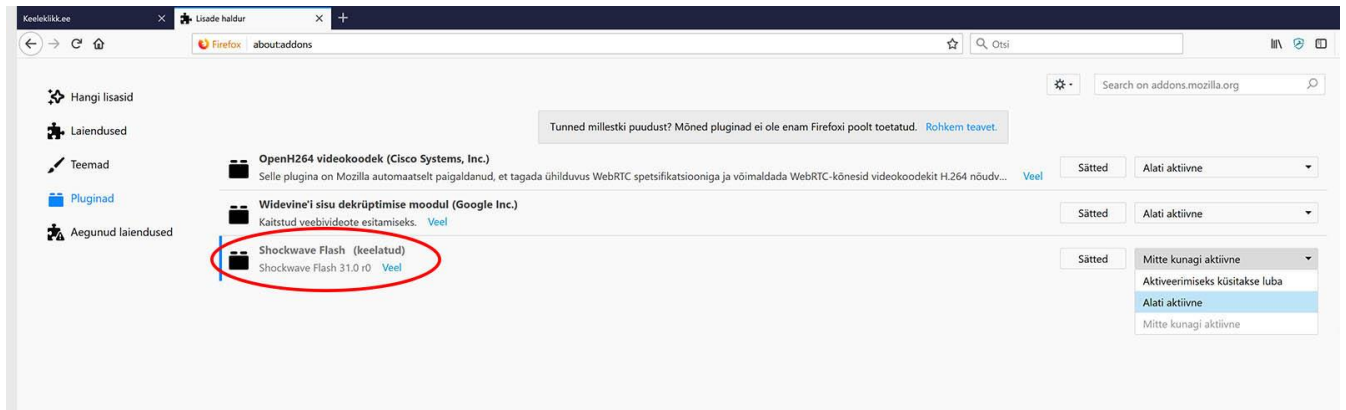
1. Click the menu button  and choose  Add-ons. The Add-ons Manager tab will open.



2. In the Add-ons Manager tab, select the **Plugins** panel.



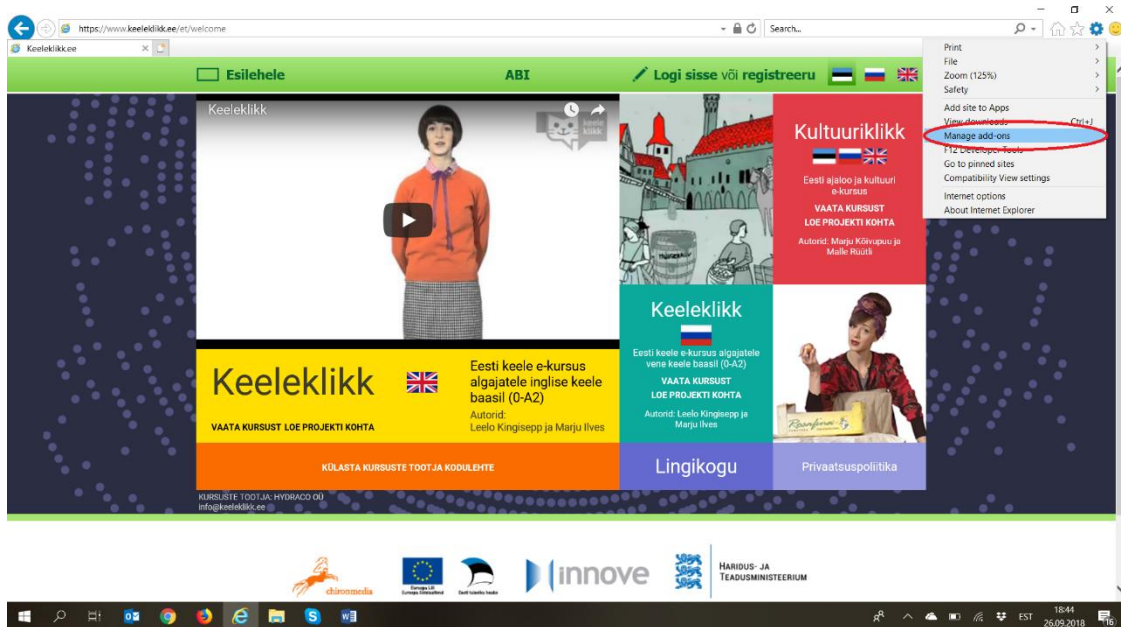
3. Scroll down the list of Plugins until you find Shockwave Flash (this is another name for Flash Player).
4. The enable Flash, click the drop-down box on the Shockwave Flash plugin and choose Always Activate.



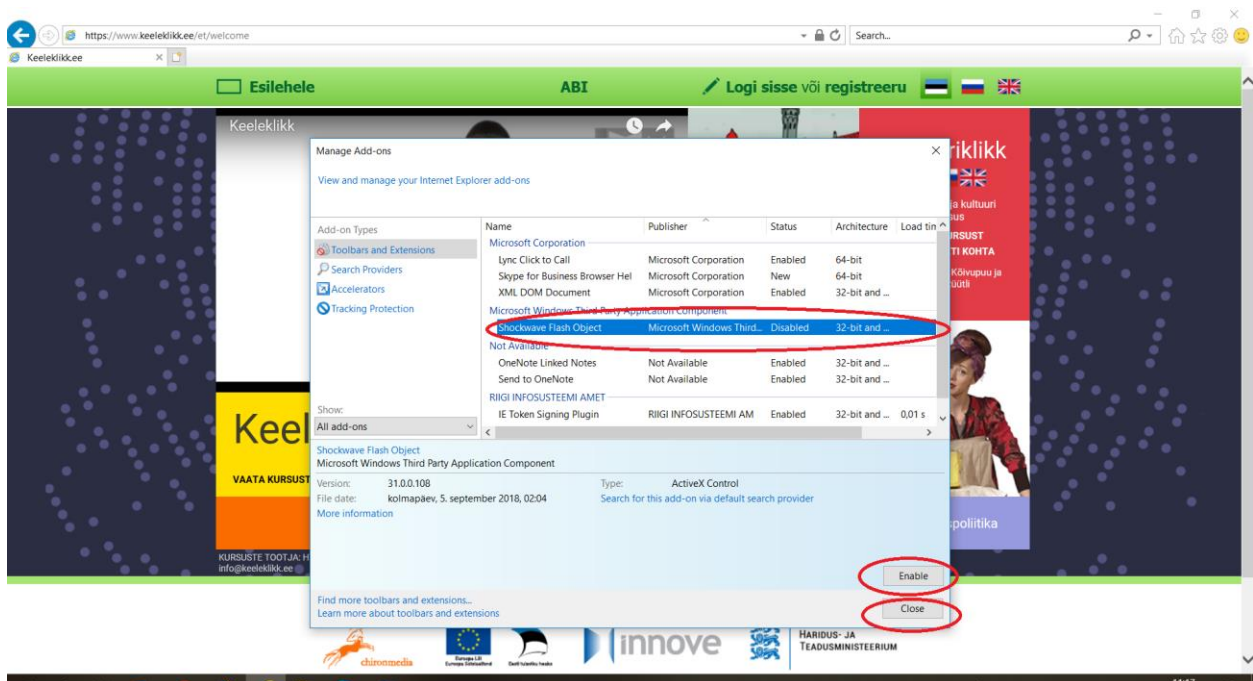
NB! This is an instruction for earlier version of Firefox. Starting in Firefox version 55, the Flash plugin is “click to play” by default.

How to enable Flash on Internet Explorer:

1. Click the Tools menu, in the upper-right corner of Internet Explorer.
2. From the Tools menu, choose Manage add-ons.

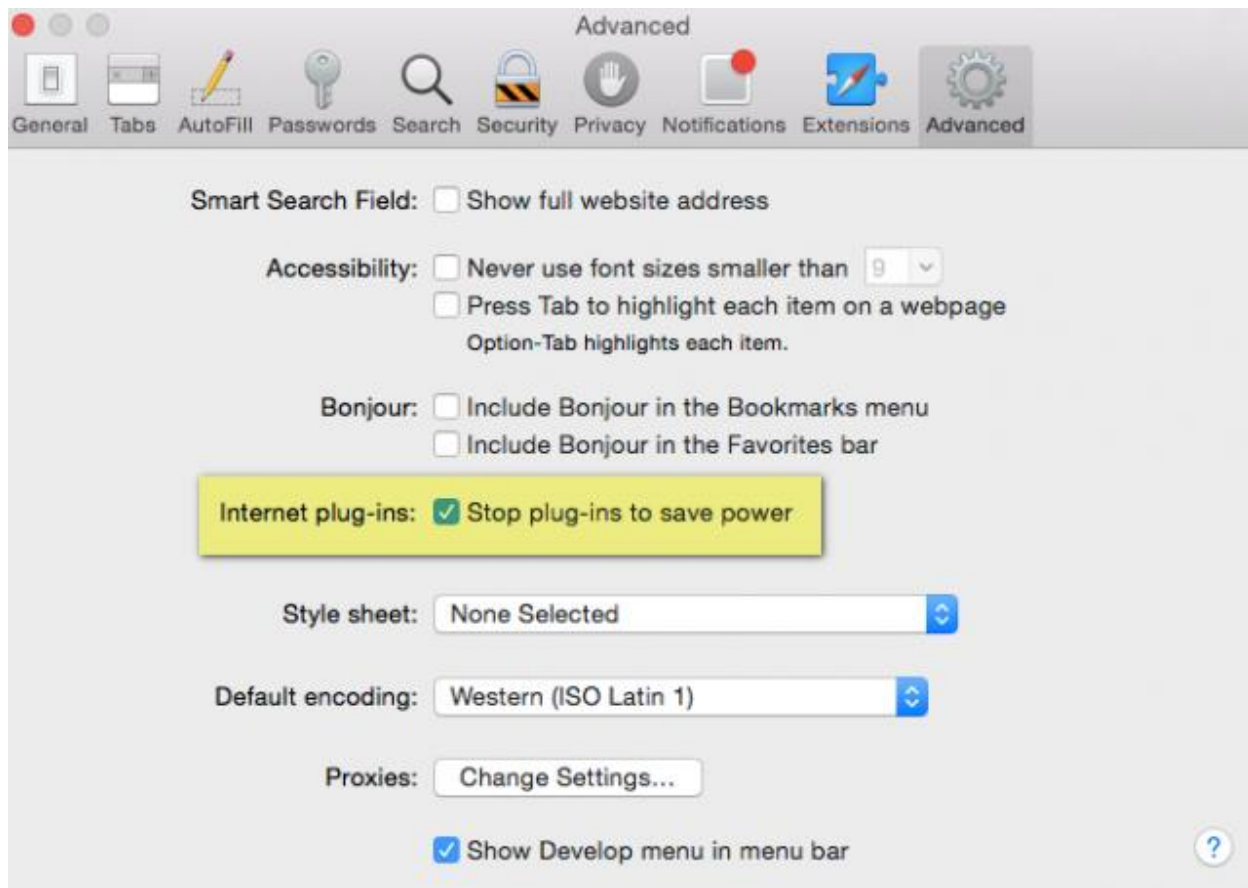


3. Select Shockwave Flash Object from the list.
4. Click Enable, and then click Close.



How to enable Flash on Mac OS X 10.11, macOS 10.12, and later.

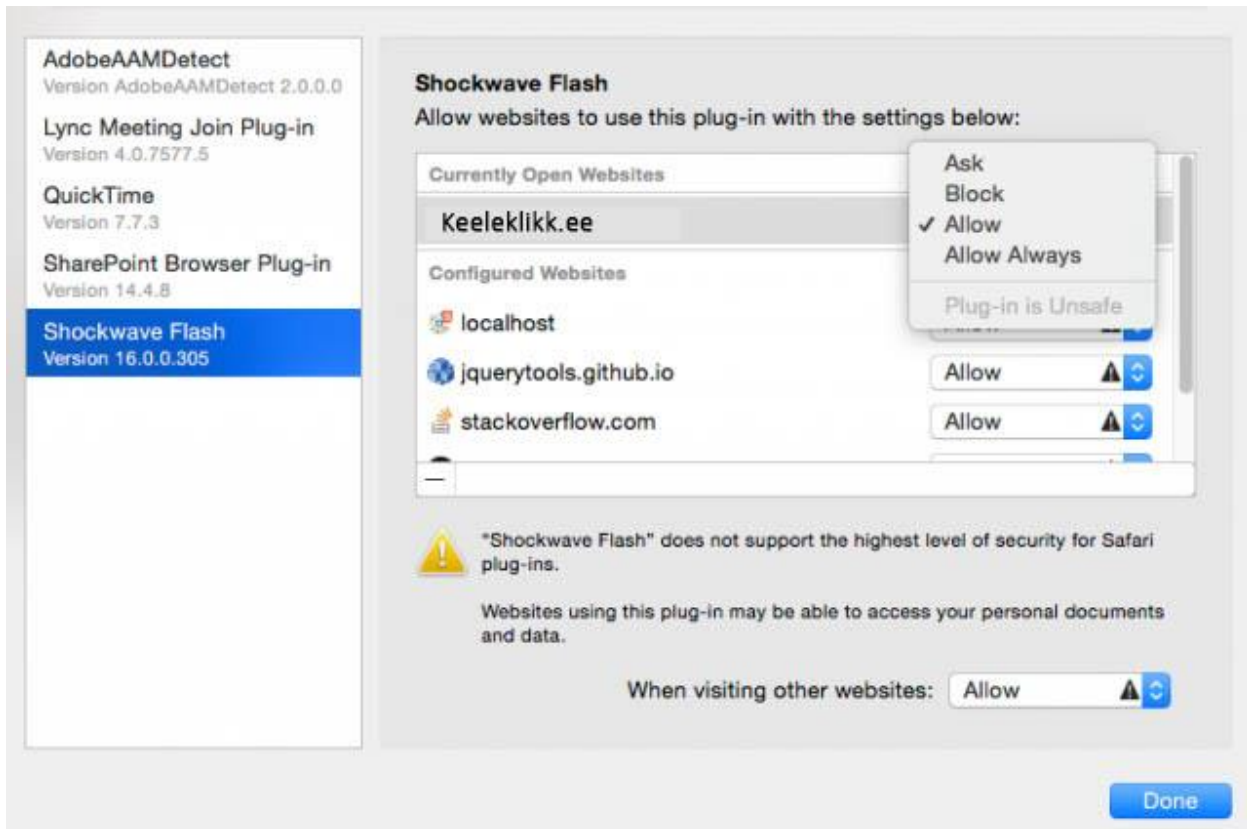
1. Go to the Safari menu and select Preferences.



2. Select the Security tab.

3. Check the Internet plug-ins and click Website Settings.

4. Select Shockwave Flash from the dropdown menu. The following window is displayed.



5. Select the Keeleklikk.ee site you want to allow Flash to be enabled.
6. Click Done and refresh the page.
